Dear Councillors,

Over the last 12 months Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils have received several requests for Community Governance Reviews. These requests have related to potentially changing Parish or Town Council boundaries and / or changing the number of Parish Councillors representing the Parish Council.

One such request has previously been approved by Mid Suffolk District Council; although the implementation of that review has been delayed as a result of the District Council's Ward Boundary Review (implemented at the May 2019 election) and multiple national elections during 2019.

Community Governance Reviews provide the opportunity for the District Council to review and make changes to community governance arrangements in their areas to reflect local circumstances, for example, in relation to changes in population or in reaction to specific or local issues.

As a result of the requests that we have received it is my intention to bring a report to each District Council in April 2020 recommending that a full Community Governance Review of all the Parishes and Towns in the Babergh and Mid Suffolk district areas is conducted during 2020. The report will detail the proposed terms of reference and time scales for the review, including consultation periods.

Suffolk County Council proposes to make the above orders for 6 districts across the County under Sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The effect of these orders is to introduce wording into existing map-based parking orders covering the districts and boroughs of Babergh, Forest Heath, Mid Suffolk, St Edmundsbury, Suffolk Coastal and Waveney which will be compliant with Civil Parking Enforcement, which comes in to effect in Suffolk on 6 April 2020. The orders will not make changes to restrictions and provisions as currently marked and signed on site, or to the current arrangements for parking permits.
